### What is the most challenging part of your job?

"Yeah so I think the challenging part is knowing time management, knowing how to balance work and life. you're trying to check off a box you know. People know if you're being genuine, if you're being real, if you're wanting to build that relationship with that person."

"This manager and I we kept in touch and he told me twice that there was an opening for the role. # What is the most rewarding part of your job?

"It's just seeing the face of someone who doesn't have it all and they just smile and look at you and they just say 'Thank you'. I mean the thank you and the hugs is probably the most rewarding thing because you know you did something for them and it's a memory that's going to last forever. Sometimes you don't even know you made an impact until they tell you."

#### Anything else you want to expand on or say before we wrap up?
