important. And as you grow to understand who your demographic is and who needs help it's important too because you won't know that unless you're in the community, unless you're there talking to different leaders. Even officers, I love talking to different officers, I love talking to different social workers, and especially organizations that focus on a lot of the families because they're the ones that really know what's going on in the community. And if you don't have that way you can communicate to build relationships with people you're not going to know those things and you're not going to be fueled by that passion to help because once you build a relationship you kind of become friends with your community leaders and they become your advocate. They can be your eyes and ears in the community because no idea is a bad idea, it's more so when is it the right time to use your idea?"

How important would you say event planning is in what you do?

"Oh my goodness I think it is very important. One, you have to have the ability to be flexible, adaptable and learn how to prioritize what's important because a lot of things come at you especially if you have two or three events you have to be organized and especially if one event is bigger than the other then you have to kind of maneuver. But yeah I mean the most important thing is just being able to be flexible because just because you have a detailed event overview it doesn't mean it's always going to go in that order or in that way and being able to think quick on your feet and understanding who you're with is important because you want to be able to just maneuver quickly. Walk throughs are so important, getting to know the area is so important, getting to know who you work with and that they're reliable, so many little details, it's really the little details that are important."

What skills are most crucial to you in the position you are in today?

"For me it's communication. I think that's important to have because you don't ever want to assume anything and like a lot of people don't like to ask questions but it's important to ask questions because maybe that one person's already thinking it and that person's shy.

Communication is so important, and then understanding people on your team because you want to be able to make sure that when you communicate situations or even ideas everyone wants to have an open mind and if something were to go wrong in an event you want to be able to say 'Hey I can fix that' or 'Hey I have a better person to fix that' because you know your team and you've communicated, you know your strengths."

"Communication even in event overviews is important. Knowing when the players are coming is important because you want to communicate with them what's going on with the event and you have to give them the talking points. Communication is definitely the key. Over-communicating is good!"

What is something you wish more people knew about community relations in sports?

"That it's not that easy in a sense that there's a lot of work and we work with so many departments internally and also externally. And I want to say we're probably one of the most hard working departments. It's never a dull day. Everyday you're planning you're executing you're also wanting to make sure that what you're going to execute follows your focus areas and organization's core values and you have to think outside the box too as well and be able to know who your resources are and have a good network. And then just getting to make sure at the end of the day that what you're projecting out there, what your event is reflects your organization and who you are too is important you know because you want to be able to value what you're putting out there for the community and make sure you're trying to give back correctly."
